Call to Ministry Essay Guidelines

Cohort #3 for Fall 2015 Admittance

Prospective RTI students must submit a single-spaced, two-page essay describing their call to ministry.

Excerpt from RTI Student Handbook, p. 11

One of the primary indicators that God may be leading you to become an RTI student is the clarity of your call to ministry. We realize that all of us are a work in progress to a certain degree, and that the specifics of a call to ministry are rarely crystallized at an early age. We also recognize that those who are effective in ministry over long periods of time are typically able to describe God's leading in their lives and the circumstances that led them to full-time ministry.

Essay Guidelines:

- The Call to Ministry essay must not exceed two, single-spaced pages using 12-pt Times New Roman font.
- The essay should include the following:
 - A short description of how you became a Christian
 - Your understanding of God's calling in your life to full-time ministry (When, where, specific scriptures that explain your call)
 - Some of the key people and experiences that have impacted you in your walk with God
 - Your rationale for pursuing full-time ministry
 - What you dream about doing as a full-time Christian worker
