Salem Alliance International and Local Workers

Ability with Language – ask God to give those who must learn another language the ability to be fluent in their adopted language.

Boldness – pray that each worker will be a bold witness for Jesus.

Comfort – pray for God’s comfort in times of discouragement, despair or mourning.

Direction – ask God to give them specific direction in ministry.

Energy – ask God to renew their energy when the tasks seem overwhelming and the body is weary.

Family Members – pray that worker’s children will have a sense of God’s presence when they’re away from their parents.

Glorify God – ask God to enable workers to live each day to glorify God.

Health – ask God to give physical and emotional health so workers can function effectively.

Insight – pray that they will have insight to see people and things from God’s perspective.

Joy – pray that the “*joy of the Lord*” will be evident in their daily living.

Knowledge – pray that workers will grow in their personal knowledge of God so they will become all that He intends.

Love – pray that God’s love will be evident in their lives; love that will draw lost people to the Father.

Mercy – pray that workers will extend the hand of mercy to those around them.

Needs – pray that they will always remember that Christ knows all that they need and will provide for them.

Open Doors – pray that they will recognize all open doors that God provides them for sharing the gospel.

Power – pray that workers will be strengthened daily by the power of God and will be equipped to live fully in His presence.

Quiet Time – pray that nothing will keep them from having a quality quiet time with God each day.

Rapport – pray that workers will have rapport with team leaders and co-workers and those they serve and enable strong relationships to develop.

Safety – pray for their safety in travel, safety from theft, safety from persecution or personal harm, and safety from the threat of war or conflict.

Trust – ask God to help workers trust Him in all things and for every situation they face.

Understanding – as workers share the gospel, ask God to give those who hear the gospel the ability to understand who Jesus is, what He did for them, and how they can have eternal life.

Victory – pray that each worker will experience victory in times of spiritual warfare.

Wisdom – ask God to give wisdom as decisions are made that affect Kingdom work and personal choices.

X-Ray Vision – pray that workers will have an introspective vision of their heart and desire to live in the righteousness of Christ.

Yielded – pray that each worker will be completely yielded to Christ and His ways.

Zealous – pray that they will be zealous in sharing the gospel.
