Sermon:

Fear is... an unpleasant often strong emotion caused by anticipation or awareness of danger.

Philippians 4:6-9

Fear is an invitation to do life with Him.

Fear is...

- 1) an unpleasant often strong emotion caused by anticipation or awareness of danger.
