Sermon:

How do we get through the “that’s not right moments”?

While the World is in Beast Mode—God’s original plan is still in place.

Recognize the Beast Mode within us.

So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won’t be doing what your sinful nature craves. The sinful nature wants to do evil, which is just the opposite of what the Spirit wants....The Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control....Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there.
