## IDEA 1

Ashley gave us some helpful reminders of what creativity is and isn't.

- Creativity does not mean being good at the arts. Creativity is simply the act of turning new and imaginative ideas into reality.
- Creativity is not always having the biggest and craziest idea in the room. Creativity is the ability to see things in new ways and generate solutions.
- Creativity is not creating new ideas or solutions out of thin air. Creativity is using the resources available in potentially new or unexpected ways.
