RECAP

As you continued to reflect on the application question from last week, "who do I want to be in 5 years?" - what thoughts came to mind? In what ways is Jesus calling you to be more like Him?

IDEA 1

Being denied access is a frustrating experience.

And that is where the story begins - A holy God and a spiritually bankrupt people - corrupted with sin and separated from accessing their creator God.

When have you been denied access? How did it feel?

If your access to God were to be limited or denied, how would that impact your life?

IDEA 2

This friends - is what we celebrate on Easter. The Peace of Christ has prevailed - the King is Risen. The mediation between God and Man was established!

Access Granted. Access to the King is now available to all.

What does it mean to you to know that you have been granted access to the King? How has this access impacted your life?

Why do you think this access is worth telling others about?

SPIRITUAL PRACTICE

Rob shared Adela's story of healing as part of the service.

It was a powerful reminder that Jesus paid for our sickness on the cross when He conquered death. He endured the punishment and by His wounds we are healed.

Is there anyone in your group who desires physical, mental, relational, emotional healing?

Take time to come before the King in prayer and ask for their healing, in the powerful name of Jesus.

APPLICATION

Read Romans 10:13-15 together:

"For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.' How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, 'How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!'"

How might you begin to share the hope, accessibility, and reassurance you find in Christ to those around you this week?

End by praying for opportunities this week to Go and Tell the Good News.
