## What we DO accept as donations:

### Kitchen/Bath

- Dining tables (no glass top)
- Dining chairs
- Barista Tables w/Barista Stools
- Microwave Stands
- New in packaging dish towels, bath towels, wash cloths

### Bedrooms

- Twin, full, queen bed mattresses and box springs (new or like-new and without spots, stains, rips, any signs of pet hair or odors, and/or bugs)
- Twin, full, and queen metal bed frames (must be complete frame set)
- Twin bunk bed frames with mattresses
- New in packaging: Bedding for twin, full, or queen size beds
- Chest of Drawers
- Dressers
- Armoires (max. 3' wide & 5' tall)
- Night stands

### Living Room Area

- Full Size Couches & Love Seats
- Recliners (rockers and swivel)
- Upholstered Arm Chairs
- Bookshelves (not to exceed 4' wide or 5' tall)
- End tables (no glass top)
- Coffee tables (no glass top)
- Area rugs (clean and spot-free)
- Small TV stands/consoles

## What we DO NOT accept as donations:

### Sorry But...

- NO Futons or hide-a-bed Couches
- NO Sectional Couches
- NO Couches with built-in recliners
- NO hutches or desks more than 4' wide
- NO large bulky display furniture
- NO large entertainment centers
- No items with glass top
- NO Bar Stools
- NO appliances/electronics
- NO king beds/mattresses/frames
- NO electronics

### Why So Picky?

This Ministry is intended to bless people in need and help them feel valued by giving them items that represent love and warmth.

Most recipients live in small housing units that are often on a 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Large items are often too large for smaller-sized dwellings.

Past experience with appliances/electronics have put the ministry team in a bind when appliances/electronics need repairs.

We do not have the capacity to repair furniture. Items need to be clean, operable and in good working order at time of pick-up.

### Other Guidelines we follow:

We **CANNOT** accept furniture that is worn, torn, faded, cat-scratched, stained, soiled, gouged, broken, visible pet hair and/or smells bad.

We **CAN** only accept furniture that is clean and operable at time of pick up.
