INTRO

What rises up in you when you hear that today there are approximately 7,500 unreached people groups—comprised of nearly 3 billion people—throughout the world?

IDEA 1

In Psalm 67 we see two great acts by God—the act of saving, of spiritual awakening (vs. 2) and the act of blessing (vs. 1, 6, & 7).

How would you answer the questions Rob asked:

"How is the saving power made known?"

"What does the blessing look like?"

IDEA 2

Our lives and our words, our declarations and demonstrations, draw people to Jesus as we call them to repentance and invite them to put their allegiance in Him—sharing our "harvest" gifted to us by our gracious God.

What role do you see yourself having in the harvest?

How can we intercede for our city and spheres of influence?

SPIRITUAL PRACTICE

Read Psalm 67 out loud.

May God be merciful and bless us.

May his face smile with favor on us.

May your ways be known throughout the earth, your saving power among people everywhere.

May the nations praise you, O God.

Yes, may all the nations praise you.

Let the whole world sing for joy, because you govern the nations with justice and guide the people of the whole world.

May the nations praise you, O God.

Yes, may all the nations praise you.

Then the earth will yield its harvests,

and God, our God, will richly bless us.

Yes, God will bless us,

and people all over the world will fear him.

Brainstorm together different ways you each can be engaging with the harvest in your daily life.

Spend some time praying and commissioning each other as you head out into your spheres of influence.
