# INTRO

This week we are focusing on Enthronement Psalms. These Psalms that celebrate God as King. They focus on God's sovereign rule and reign over all of creation - His power and majesty - He is in Control and Sustains it all.

# IDEA 1

Psalm 24 is an entrance liturgy - preparing, warming up the people to encounter the main act - YHWH himself. Throughout Rob's portion of the sermon he led us in a Call to Worship.

Have you engaged in a Call to Worship before? What was that experience like for you?

How was your attention drawn to God during this time?

# IDEA 2

Psalm 93 was written after God brought the Israelites back to the land from the Babylonian exile. It reminds the reader that in the midst of, indeed in spite of, the onslaught of the terrible things of life, God is more powerful, He reigns, He is in control.

What are the things in your life at the moment that seem out of control?

How does the truth that God is sovereign, that He is in control and sustains all things impact you?

### SPIRITUAL PRACTICE

God's greatness, in every season of our life, moments of pain and celebrations of joy... deserves to be published and proclaimed as offerings of worship

Ask your Life Group to reflect on the following question:

"What is the part of my story I'm prepared to share for the glory of God?"

(Pause to reflect and invite Holy Spirit to highlight a part of your to story to share for the glory of God)

### Invite people to share their story with the group as an act of worship.
