LOCATION AND HOURS

The Church Library is inside Faith Annex at the corner of 5th and Gaines St. Our entrance is the single door on 5th Street. Look for “Library Open” signs by the library entrance.

An accessible entrance with a ramp is on the north side of the building, facing the Broadway Commons parking lot.

The library is open before and after each service on Saturday evenings and Sunday mornings.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The library is for regular attendees of Salem Alliance Church. New patrons will be asked to fill out a registration form before using the library.
- Items are checked out for a 3-week period and can be renewed either in person or via email request.
- Drop boxes to return items are located inside the library and below the church staff mailboxes in the main building.
- Late fees are 25 cents per item per week.
- Patrons are asked to replace any lost or damaged items.

Check-out limits:

DVDs: 2 per household at a time

Children's books: 6 per household at a time

Search, by author, title, subject or series (fiction).

- By Author – last name, first name (or initial)
- By Title – omit “A”, “An”, “The” at the beginning of a title
- “Any word” – use when you want a broad search, e.g., all resources that contain the word “faith” in the title, subject or author’s name.
- “Find all words” – use when you can’t remember the exact title but have a couple words. This will sort for words that are non-consecutive.
